Addendum Number One (1)

Collectible Waste Tender Questions and Answers

The following questions were raised during the question period relating to the Collectible Waste Tender:

1. *“Will the Town accept a Bid Bond for \$15,000 in place of a certified cheque for Bid Deposit?”*

Answer: No; the Town now amends the request for tender for Collectible Waste by deleting the below mentioned paragraph 4.2 TENDER DEPOSIT with the result that no tender deposit is required either by way of a certified cheque, bank draft or bid bond for \$15,000.00.

#### **4.2 TENDER DEPOSIT**

A Tender Deposit of Fifteen Thousand (\$15,000) Dollars is required to be submitted with the tender submission.

The deposits of unsuccessful tender submissions shall be returned within fifteen (15) calendar days of acceptance of the successful tender by the Municipality. The deposits of the two preferred tender submissions will be retained until an Agreement has been executed by the Successful Tender Respondent and the required performance security and bond has been furnished to the satisfaction of the Municipality. Any tender deposit that is returned will be returned in the original form as it was received.

If a tender has not been accepted within sixty (60) days of Tender Closing, any tender may be withdrawn by any tender Respondent and the deposit will be returned on demand. No compensation will be made in the event of delay in executing an Agreement.

If the successful Respondent fails to furnish the required bonds, insurance certificates or other such required documents within seven (7) calendar days of acceptance by the Municipality, the Municipality can withdraw the award of the Contract and the tender deposit accompanying the tender will be forfeited to the Municipality. This action does not limit the Municipality's right to recover loss, damage or expense incurred by the Municipality as a result of the tender Respondent's default including, but not limited to, the additional costs associated with selecting another Contractor.

The Tender Deposit, in favour of the Municipality may be in the form of a certified cheque certified by the Bank upon which it is drawn or a bank draft. All tender deposits shall be in Canadian Funds. No interest shall be payable on any tender deposit.

Following acceptance of a tender by the Municipality, should the successful tender Respondent refuse to enter into a Contract, the Municipality, at its sole discretion, may cash the tender deposit and deposit the certified cheque or bank draft to the Municipality’s account without prejudice to the Municipality’s other rights in law.

Additionally the Town advises Respondents that the line reading:

Tender Deposit - \$15,000.00 Certified Cheque or Bank Draft

Is therefor deleted from SCHEDULE A – TENDER CHECKLIST

2. *“Can actual waste and recycling weights be provided from 2017?”*

Answer: No, the actual waste (garbage/solid waste) and recycling weights cannot be provided for 2017; however, an estimated weight that was reported for the 2017 RPRA Datacall for recycling weight is as follows:

Fiber	Co-mingled	Old Corrugated Cardboard
237 metric tonnes	95 metric tonnes	113.5 metric tonnes

Actual weight cannot be provided for household waste (garbage/solid waste) as it is not weighed.

3. *“Is fibre and gmp collected separately on alternating weeks or together on alternating weeks for the new contract?”*

Answer: Fibre and recycle containers (gmp) are expected to be collected separately on alternating weeks as outlined on Schedule C page 38.

Recycling (Fibre) Collection and Disposal – collected every other week (week number 1)

Recycling (Containers) Collection and Disposal – collected every other week (week number 2)

Regarding the Multi-Residential and IC&I routes N.B. Both streams (Recycling Fiber and Recycling Containers (gmp) must be collected weekly.

4. *“Will the Town consider a 4 day collection (Tue-Fri) instead of a 5 day collection (Tue-Sat)?”*

Answer: Yes, the Town will consider a 4 day collection (Mon-Fri) or any other alternate schedule that provides at least weekly pick up for residential routes, this tender document is not intended to determine collection days for residential waste or recycling collection. All Multi-residential and IC&I routes must have both streams collected each week, as outlined in paragraph 3. above.

5. *“Is the contractor responsible for the cost in changing the collection schedule prior to contract start date?”*

Answer: No, the Town of Deep River will cover the advertising costs for changes to the collection schedule prior to the contract start date conditional upon the Town of Deep River agreeing to recommended changes.

6. *“Are weight tickets required for the waste stream itself as there is no scale at the Baggs landfill? If so, where are they currently being scaled or where will they be scaled?”*

Answer: No, weight tickets are not required for the waste stream. 5.1 Summary of Services reads;

*“The Contractor is required to provide the Municipality with weights of all waste streams collected on a monthly basis”*

This can be interpreted as estimated weights or actual weights.

7. *“Can the Town provide a list of all commercial and multi-residential locations?”*

*Answer: Yes, please see the list for IC&I and Multi- Residential Below:*
