## The Future of Fire Services in Deep River

### WHAT RESIDENTS MIGHT WANT TO KNOW

On Monday, May 28 2018 the Town of Deep River and Canadian Nuclear Laboratories (CNL) signed a Fire Protection Services Agreement that builds on the interim agreement that was signed in December 2017.

The Agreement is effective June 1, 2018 and remains in force until March 31, 2021 with an option to extend the agreement or renegotiate it at that time.

This new Agreement bolsters the existing fire service in Deep River and enhances capacity through the expertise and leadership of CNL Fire Operations, supporting a return to 24/7 coverage in the Deep River fire hall.

At the same time, the Town in partnership with CNL, is moving forward immediately to recruit volunteer firefighters and establish a composite fire department.

This complement of current full-time Deep River firefighters, together with volunteers, will be trained and provided operational oversight by CNL senior fire personnel.

#### HIGHLIGHTS

#### Fire Protection Services Agreement Town of Deep River and Canadian Nuclear Laboratories (CNL)

##### CNL Responsibilities

- CNL will provide a Fire Chief and Deputy Fire Chief to the Town as well as a staff complement for the following positions – Fire Prevention Officer, CNL Officer Firefighters, CNL Firefighters – up to 14,000 person hours per year
- CNL will provide training services for the Deep River Fire Personnel to maintain current required qualifications and provide any additional necessary training
- CNL will provide administration and operational oversight of the Deep River Fire Service

##### Town Responsibilities

- The Town is responsible for Deep River Fire Personnel, including volunteers and full-time firefighters
- The Town is responsible for maintaining a fully functional fire hall and firefighting equipment, together with Personal Protective Equipment for its firefighters and all support services related to their management

##### Level of Service


- The following fire services will be provided for Deep River residents and businesses:
  - Fire prevention and education
  - Fire suppression and investigations
  - Medical assist responses
  - Land-based ice and water rescue
  - Extrication using manual and heavy hydraulic tools
  - Response to hazardous materials leaks and spills

- This Agreement supports a return to 24/7 on-duty coverage in the Deep River fire hall.

#### Terms and Conditions under the Agreement

- This Agreement is effective June 1, 2018 and remains in force and effect until March 31, 2021 with the option to extend the agreement or negotiate a new agreement at that time
- Both parties can terminate this Agreement without cause by giving one year's advance written notice to the other party.
