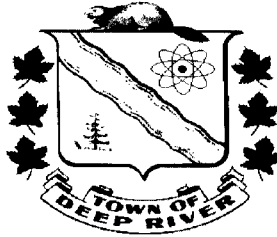

JUNIOR INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM GRANT GUIDELINES

THE PURPOSE OF THE GRANT IS TO PROVIDE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO NON-PROFIT, COMMUNITY BASED CLUBS THAT PROVIDE DIRECT INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMS THAT ENHANCE THE QUALITY OF LIFE FOR DEEP RIVER'S CHILDREN/YOUTH IN THE AREA OF ARTS, CULTURE AND SPORTS.

1. Any grant monies for junior programs must be directed to the junior program only and should not be used to support the senior membership in any way.
2. Monies must be directed towards individuals officially registered in the junior instructional program, not towards juniors who happen to be members of the club not registered in the instructional program.
3. No grants will be awarded on the basis that programs received grants in previous years. Each club shall apply each year for a grant.
4. Junior programs must be instructional.
5. Clubs receiving grants must advertise that fact that monies to assist with their program have been received from the municipality.
6. As the request for financial support each year exceeds the funds available, all applications will be assessed in a comparative context that takes into a consideration of:
 - A The viability of the program without financial assistance.
 - B The number of residents served by the clubs program.
 - C The quality of the program.
 - D The availability of the instruction elsewhere.
 - E The level of volunteer support and activity.
 - F If the club demonstrates and provides instructional programs in an effective accessible, open and inclusive manner.
 - G Fundraising activities
