- ➤ Red Cross Level 10
- ➤ Lifesaving Society Bronze star (Must be 12 years of age)
- ➤ Lifesaving Society Bronze Medallion (Must be 13 years of age or completed Bronze Star)
- ➤ Lifesaving Society Bronze Cross/ Emergency First Aid (Must be 14 years of age and completed Bronze Medallion)*
- > Red Cross Standard First Aid level "C"/AED (Must be 14 years of age)*
- ➤ Red Cross Water Safety Instructor

(Must be 15 years of age). Must complete a minimum of 8 volunteer hours of apprentice teaching with a certified Water Safety Instructor before Instructor course. Volunteer hours can be used towards the mandatory 40 volunteer hours to graduate high school. **

- Lifesaving Society Water Safety Instructor (Must be 16 years of age and complete Bronze Cross) *
- ➤ Lifesaving Society NLS National Lifeguard Service (Pool) (Must be 16 years of age, completed Bronze Cross and Standard First Aid, CPR "C") **
- * Must have to be able to work at the Deep River Community Pool as a cashier or maintenance person
- ** Must have certificates to lifeguard and teach swimming lessons at the Deep River Community Pool and/or Lamure Beach.
- *** An asset to hold to be able to teach Bronze courses.
