### **BACKYARD HENS**

### PILOT PROJECT SURVEY

- DEEP RIVER -

#### **MASKS**

Addresses ending in 1, 3, 5, 7 or 9 may water their lawns on "odd numbered calendar dates", i.e., June 3rd, July 15th, August 21st,

The "Permitted Hours" are: 7:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. only.
