### SIDEWALKS ARE FOR PEDESTRIANS

Cyclists be aware of By-Law

#### Town of Deep River BY-LAW #103

A By-law to prohibit the use of bicycles upon any Sidewalk, Pathway or Foot Path is as follows:

That no bicycle or any self-propelled vehicle shall be ridden or driven along or upon any side-walk, pathway or foot path used by, or set apart for the use of, pedestrians.

The Penalty – Every person who contravenes the provisions of this By-law shall be subject to a fine of not more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00).
