Lane Swim Protocols

- Swim times will be 30 minute time slots except during Tuesday and Thursday evenings. Two members from the same household may share a
- Swimmers will be required to preregister for their time slot by calling the Deep River Community Pool at 613-584-2000 ext. 181 or 182.
- Swimmers may book 3 time slots if available.Swimmers will be COVID screened at the front
- door prior to entering.
- A 20 Swim Card can be purchased by credit card over the telephone or in person at the Town Hall with any form of payment.
- Showers are still required before entering the pool.
- Showers can be used after the swim but access to the change room is limited.

Family Swim Protocols

- FAMILY definition: Up to six members of the same household.
- The Pool's Admission Standard is still in effect with a parent or caregiver being in the water within arm's reach for children 10 years and under who have not completed the swim test.
- Families will be required to preregister their 1 HOUR swim time by calling the Deep River Community Pool at 613-584-2000 ext. 181 or

Families may book three time slots if available.

- One family per one third of the pool (full lane access). Up to 3 families per swim time.
- Please arrive a few minutes prior to your swim time for a Covid19 health screening, and to be advised of your lane assignment.
- It is strongly encouraged for swimmers to arrive at the Pool wearing their swim wear
- Swimmers are encouraged to bring their own training equipment, lifejacket (PFDs) and small toys.
- Access to toilets will be available.
- · Access to the change room is limited. Lockers will not be available. A chair will be located at the shallow end of your lane to store your belongings.
- Swimmers have access to the change room up to 10 minutes AFTER their swim time
- The Sauna is closed.
- Exit of the facility will be through the shallow end emergency exit.
- Swimmers are to adhere to physical distancing protocols.


Criminal Record Checks

The Deep River Police Service is now resuming Criminal Record Checks, Vulnerable Sector Searches and Fingerprints for Employment, School and Volunteering. Following the COVID-19 Guidelines, anyone entering the police station is required to wear a mask and answer a DRPS Health Assessment Questionnaire.

The CRC/VSS application form will be available on the Town website to download and complete. Please note the list of acceptable pieces of identification to bring with you. Requests related to employment, volunteering, and education within the Vulnerable Sector will require a written letter of request from the Employer /School / Volunteer Organization. Forms to be signed at the Police Station for verification purposes. Once your form has been filled in, call the police station at (613) 584-3500 to book an appointment to complete the process. The cost for the records check is \$28.00 (tax incl.) and is to be paid at the Town office.

Should fingerprints be required during present state of emergency, COVID-19 Guidelines will be adhered to: anyone entering the police station is required to wear a mask and answer a DRPS Health Assessment Questionnaire. If the records check is for employment purposes, please bring the appropriate paperwork. Fingerprints are \$58.00 and to be paid at the Town office.
