### PREPARING FOR DRIVING IN WINTER

Stay alert, slow down, and stay in control — the three key elements of safe winter driving. Drive according to highway and weather conditions. Maintain a safe following distance between you and the vehicle in front of you to avoid situations where you may have to brake suddenly.

### BE PREPARED — IS YOUR VEHICLE READY?

Get your vehicle winter-ready with a **maintenance check-up**. Don't wait for winter to have your tires, battery, belts, hoses, radiator, oil, lights, brakes, exhaust system, heater/defroster, wipers and ignition system checked. Always be sure you have **sufficient windshield washer fluid** in the reservoir. You may wish to keep an extra jug in the vehicle.
