POLICE

If heat stroke is suspected (excessive panting and drooling, listlessness or unconsciousness) prompt veterinary medical attention is vital. In the meantime, wet the fur immediately with lukewarm to cool water, not cold water. Bring the pet into the shade and offer drinking water.



Dogs have a limited ability to sweat; even a short time in a hot environment can be life-threatening. A dog's normal body temperature is about 39°C, a temperature of 41°C can be withstood only for a very short time before irreparable brain damage or even death can occur.

If you can't take your pet with you when you leave your car, leave them at home where they are safe.

It's imperative that each of us as animal owners is responsible in providing the proper care for our pets. As such, leaving a pet unattended in a vehicle is one of the most irresponsible things a pet owner can do.

- Swim times will be 30 minute time slots. Only one
- Swimmers will be required to preregister for their 30 minute time slot by calling the Deep River Community Pool at 6135842000 ext. 181 or 182.
- Swimmers may book two time slots if available.
 Swimmers will be COVID screened at the front door prior to entering.

 • A 20 Swim Card can be purchased by credit card
- over the telephone or in person at the Town Hall with any form of payment. If a cash payment is being made, exact payment is required
- It is strongly encouraged for swimmers to arrive
- and leave the Pool wearing their swimwear.

 Swimmers are encouraged to bring their own training equipment.
- Showers are still required before entering the pool.
 Showers can be used after the swim but access to the change room is limited.
- Access to toilets will be available.Lockers will not be available. A chair will be located at the shallow end of your lane to store your belongings.
- Swimmers have up to 10 minutes to leave deck after their swim time.
- The Sauna is closed.
- Exit of the facility will be through the shallow end
- Swimmers are to adhere to physical distancing
