#### A commonly asked question in Deep River:

I have locate paint on my property, and I did not request a locate. Can you tell me who did?

A: Excavators request locates for a variety of reasons. Cities dig to repair water and sewer lines or rebuild roads/sidewalks. Infrastructure owners dig to repair or upgrade their lines, etc. Please keep in mind that the municipality you live in, technically, "owns" the land up to your property line. If they must excavate on the publicly owned portion of the property, they may do so without consulting you first. While there is no arguing that you own your private property, the infrastructure buried underneath that property are owned by the respective owner. It is the policy of most companies and certainly a courtesy to notify you of any planned excavation.

ON1Call's Privacy Policy forbids ON1Call Representatives from discussing locate requests with anyone but the person who requested the locate, an ON1Call member, or a third party investigative body/legal body.
