TOWN OF DEEP RIVER COUNCIL MEETINGS DURING COVID-19

MASKS

In accordance with the local directive released by the Renfrew County District Health Unit (RCDHU) requiring masks or face coverings (this includes cloth and disposable masks, bandanas and scarves) to be worn in enclosed public spaces.

Masks are mandatory when entering the Town of Deep River Facilities. Notices will be posted on doors to remind Residents to wear a mask or face covering upon entry. We encourage Residents to bring their own mask however disposable masks will be made available at the entrance for those who do not have a mask (while mask supplies last).

WATERING RESTRICTIONS APPLY FROM MAY 1 - SEPT 30 (INCLUSIVE)

A watering permit issued by the Town of Deep River will only allow you to water within the permitted hours each day. Watering permits do not permit all day watering.

Addresses ending in 0, 2, 4, 6 or 8 may water their lawns on "even numbered calendar dates", i.e.: May 2nd, June 30th, July 18th, and August 6th.

Addresses ending in 1, 3, 5, 7 or 9 may water their lawns on "odd numbered calendar dates", i.e., June 3rd, July 15th, August 21st, and September 7th.

The "Permitted Hours" are: 7:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. only.

Never leave a child alone in a car

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, health officials said the number could be even higher this year as more people have their vehicles at home or may decide to leave their children in a car when they go shopping.

Restrictions at stores could tempt some parents to leave their child in the car to decrease the risk of exposure to COVID-19 while they shop, but even with the window cracked or the vehicle parked in the shade, the interior temperature can become extremely hot in a short period of time.

"Children's bodies heat up three to five times faster than adults. That's why it's never safe for them to be left unattended inside of a closed vehicle," Emily Thomas with Consumer Reports said. "It doesn't matter if you're parked in the shade, or you've left the window cracked, or even if you think it's not that hot out. It affects them differently and it's never safe."

Parents are advised to get in the habit of checking the back seat before locking their car doors.

Another strategy is putting your cell phone in the back whenever a child is there so you'll see them when you go to retrieve your phone.

Still the best practice is to leave your children with another adult when you have to go out to do shopping or run errands.

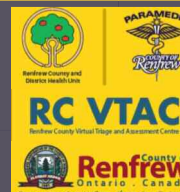
