MASKS

Lane Swim Protocols

- Swim times will be 30 minute time slots. Only one swimmer per lane.
- Swimmers will be required to preregister for their 30 minute time slot by calling the Deep River Community Pool at 6135842000 ext. 181 or 182.
- Swimmers may book two time slots if available. Swimmers will be COVID screened at the front door prior to entering.
- A 20 Swim Card can be purchased by credit card over the telephone or in person at the Town Hall with any form of payment. If a cash payment is being made, exact payment is required.
- It is strongly encouraged for swimmers to arrive at the Pool wearing their swim wear
- Swimmers are encouraged to bring their own training equipment.
- Showers are still required before entering the pool.
- Showers can be used after the swim but access to the change room is limited.
- Access to toilets will be available.
- Lockers will not be available. A chair will be located at the shallow end of your lane to store your belongings.
- Swimmers have access to the change room up to 10 minutes AFTER their swim time
- The Sauna is closed.
- Exit of the facility will be through the shallow end emergency exit.
- Swimmers are to adhere to physical distancing protocols.

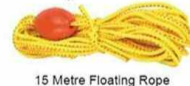

WATERING RESTRICTIONS APPLY FROM MAY 1 - SEPT 30 (INCLUSIVE)

A watering permit issued by the Town of Deep River will only allow you to water within the permitted hours each day. Watering permits do not permit all day watering.

Addresses ending in 0, 2, 4, 6 or 8 may water their lawns on "even numbered calendar dates", i.e.: May 2nd, June 30th, July 18th, and August 6th.

Addresses ending in 1, 3, 5, 7 or 9 may water their lawns on "odd numbered calendar dates", i.e., June 3rd, July 15th, August 21st, and September 7th.

The "Permitted Hours" are: 7:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. only.
