BY-LAW



In accordance with By-Law No. 35-2013,
households within the boundaries of the
Town of Deep River shall not exceed 2 dogs
and 3 cats per dwelling unit.

Owners are required to have animals on a
leash, at all times, when outside in any area
within the boundaries of the Town of Deep
River.

MUNICIPAL ACCOMMODATION TAX INFORMATION SESSION

Tourism accommodators operating in the Town of
Deep River are invited to an information session to
learn more about the Municipal Accommodation
Tax (*Ontario Regulation 435/17 - Transient
Accommodation Tax, under the Municipal Act, 2001*).

Effective December 1, 2017, the Province of
Ontario granted municipalities the authority to
implement a tax on transient accommodations of
30 days or less. The tax revenue generated, which
must be shared between a municipality and an
eligible tourism entity, would support new and
existing tourism development and marketing
efforts in the area.
