### **BY-LAW**



In accordance with By-Law No. 35-2013, households within the boundaries of the Town of Deep River shall not exceed 2 dogs and 3 cats per dwelling unit.

Owners are required to have animals on a leash, at all times, when outside in any area within the boundaries of the Town of Deep River.

# **MUNICIPAL ACCOMMODATION** TAX INFORMATION **SESSION**

Tourism accommodators operating in the Town of Deep River are invited to an information session to learn more about the Municipal Accommodation Tax (Ontario Regulation 435/17 - Transient Accommodation Tax, under the Municipal Act, 2001).

Effective December 1, 2017, the Province of Ontario granted municipalities the authority to implement a tax on transient accommodations of 30 days or less. The tax revenue generated, which must be shared between a municipality and an eligible tourism entity, would support new and existing tourism development and marketing efforts in the area.
