THEFT PREVENTION TIPS FOR **BUSINESSES**

- Remove all valuables from storefront displays
- Remove all cash from tills and leave open with the cash tray out and visibly empty
- Ensure alarm systems are working and all contact lists are up-to-date
- Post on doors/windows that the premises are monitored by an alarm company and that no money is kept on the premises. Include the 613-584-3500 number to call Police should anyone notice a break-in or damage
- Clean all windows and floors prior to leaving and note when you've done so (have a log) as this will help investigators should there be a break-in
- Consider a surveillance system which can be monitored remotely by phone/online
- Consider putting a laminate on all windows/glass to discourage and help prevent easy entry
- Keep some lighting on inside to help with video surveillance and consider lighting on timers if
- Ensure all doors and windows are locked and secure
- Ensure all exterior lighting is functioning and on consider motion sensor lights as another option
- Remove anything on the exterior which could be used to gain entry to your premises (bricks, ladders, poles, construction materials)
- · Regularly check the building and keep track of when you check (have a log) but go at different times
- Like your home, if it looks cared for and looks like someone is home or around regularly, thieves will move on to other locations

The Deep River Police and the Deep River Police Services Board request that we all help keep our families, communities and businesses safe and secure during this State of Emergency.

If you see any suspicious activity around a business that you know is closed or any homes where people aren't around, call the police to report it.

WATERING RESTRICTIONS APPLY FROM MAY 1 - SEPT 30 (INCLUSIVE).

A watering permit issued by the Town of Deep River will only allow you to water within the permitted hours each day. Watering permits do not permit all day watering.

Addresses ending in 0, 2, 4, 6 or 8 may water their lawns on "even numbered calendar dates", i.e.: May 2nd, June 30th, July 18th, and August 6th.

Addresses ending in 1, 3, 5, 7 or 9 may water their lawns on "odd numbered calendar dates", i.e., June 3rd, July 15th, August 21st, and September 7th.

The "Permitted Hours" are: 7:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. only.


