NOTICE OF OPEN HOUSE AND PUBLIC MEETING

COMPREHENSIVE ZONING BY-LAW REVIEW

The Town of Deep River is hosting an Open House and Public Meeting to obtain public input on the proposed review of the Town's Comprehensive Zoning By-law. This review is required under Section 26 (9) of the Planning Act in order to implement the policies of the Town's Official Plan, which was approved on October 25, 2017.

The Open House and Public Meeting is being hosted at the beginning of the review to provide the public with an explanation of the zoning by-law review process and how the public can participate. A summary of planning topics to be addressed during the zoning by-law review will also be presented. Public input and comments are invited for general or site specific planning matters that should be considered during the zoning by-law review. Additional information about the zoning by-law review will be presented at the Open House and Public Meeting.
