#### Beware of Fraud and Phishing Scams

During this time of year many people decide to buy gifts for Christmas online. This is relatively convenient and safe, however it is also when many people attempt to defraud victims or gather personal information.

Be cautious when receiving an email regarding a refund or confirmation of credit card used. A company should not be asking you to re-enter your credit card information in a separate email. Some emails may ask you to "click the link" to confirm address or other information during delivery.

If you are skeptical about any email you receive, contact the company directly or ask a friend or family member for a second opinion before disclosing any information online.

### NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING AND OPEN HOUSE

*In the matter of Section 34 of the Planning Act, the Town of Deep River hereby gives NOTICE OF THE FOLLOWING:*

- A public meeting regarding updates to the Town of Deep River Zoning By-law.
- An open house regarding all updates to the Town of Deep River Zoning By-law.

**Subject** Update to the Zoning By-law of the Town of Deep River.

**Public Meeting** A public meeting to inform the public of the proposed Zoning By-law update will be held on Tuesday, December 10, 2019, at 7:00 p.m. at the municipal office of the Town of Deep River.

**Open House** An open house to provide the public with an opportunity to review and discuss the Comprehensive Zoning By-law will be held on Tuesday, December 10, 2019, from 4:00 to 6:00 p.m. at the municipal office of the Town of Deep River.

#### Proposed Zoning By-law Amendment

The purpose of these changes is to update the Town of Deep River Comprehensive Zoning By-law. All changes will be outlined in a draft copy of the Zoning By-law, where it will be indicated what has been added or removed to/from the Town of Deep River Comprehensive Zoning By-law. Additional information regarding the Zoning By-law is available for inspection at the Town of Deep River Municipal Office during regular office hours.

This Zoning by-law applies to all lands within the geographic area of the Town of Deep River. A key map is therefore not provided.

If you wish to be notified of the decision of the Town of Deep River on the proposed zoning by-law amendment, you must make a written request to Ric McGee, CAO/Clerk, Town of Deep River, P.O. Box 400, 100 Deep River Road, Deep River, ON K0J 1P0.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Town of Deep River before the by-law is passed by the Town of Deep River, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Town of Deep River, to the Local Planning Appeals Tribunal.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting, or make written submissions to the Town of Deep River before the by-law is passed by the Town, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Local Planning Appeals Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to do so.

**NOTE: One of the purposes of the Planning Act is to provide for planning processes that are open, accessible, timely and efficient. Accordingly, all written submissions, documents, correspondence, e-mails or other communications (including your name and address) form part of the public record and will be disclosed/made available by the Municipality to such persons as the Municipality sees fit, including anyone requesting such information. Accordingly, in providing such information, you shall be deemed to have consented to its use and disclosure as part of the planning process.**
