8 TIPS FOR FIREPLACE SAFETY

Have your chimney inspected & cleaned annually by a specialist	Clear the area around the hearth of debris, and flammable materials	Use only seasoned hardwood - soft wood adds creosote buildup	Always use a screen around the fireplace to catch sparks.
Never burn cardboard boxes, trash, or debris in your fireplace	Never leave a fire unattended - extinguish before leaving the house	Place logs at the rear of the fireplace or on a supporting grate	Empty ashes from your fireplace into a metal trashcan with lid
