The service is available and completed while you wait, Monday to Friday from 8:30 am to 12:30 pm and 1:30 pm to 4:30 pm. Please bring 2 pieces of ID, one with a picture. Payment is made at the Town office. Only debit, cash and cheques are accepted.
