DEEP RIVER COMMUNITY POOL SAFETY GUIDELINES

- Please wear a mask or face covering while walking in the facility and change rooms.
- The cashier will be situated inside the front door of the pool.
- ****NEW as of September 22, 2021, individuals 12 years and up MUST be double vaccinated to access the Deep River Community Pool for public and lane swims as per Public Health protocols.**
- **Exemption**—Patrons under 18 years of age who are entering the facility solely for the purpose of actively participating in an organized sport; ie swimming lesson.
- Proof of vaccination will be required each time you enter the facility.
- Patrons with medical exemption are required to present identification and a written document stating the individual is exempt for a medical reason and the effective time-period for the medical reason.
- Please arrive a few minutes prior to your swim time for a Covid-19 health screening.
- A **Swim Card** can be purchased by credit card online at <https://app.booking.ca/DeepRiverPub/> , over the telephone or in-person at the Town Hall with any form of payment. Cash payment will be accepted at the pool.
- Swimmers may pre-register for their time slot either in-person at the pool OR by calling the Deep River Community Pool at 613-584-2000 ext. 182 but not necessary.
- Lane Swim times will be 1 hour. Lane Swim is returning to the 3 lane set up of Fast/Medium and Other. Once 5 patrons are in the lane, circle swimming is required.
- Family admission is \$12.00 and Toddler admission is \$5.00. We request exact payment. Pre-booking is encouraged. Drop-in's are welcome.
- The Pool's Admission Standard is still in effect with a parent or caregiver being in the water within arm's reach for children 10 years and under who have not completed the swim test.
- Access to showers and toilets are available. The sauna and the lockers are not available at this time.
- Chairs will be located at the shallow end of the lane to store your belongings/masks.
- Swimmers have access to the change room up to 10 minutes AFTER their swim time.
- Swimmers are encouraged to bring their own training equipment. lifejackets (pfd's) and small toys.
- Indoor shoes are required while on pool deck. **Please leave your outdoor shoes in the lobby.**
- Walking traffic in the facility has returned to pre-Covid flow.
