CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF DEEP RIVER WINTER PARKING REGULATIONS



It is the desire of the Corporation of the Town of Deep River to provide a high level of service, safety and convenience, equitably to all users. To achieve this, it is mandatory that all renters abide by the following regulations while your boat is parked within the Marina upper parking lot.

- 1. This form must be submitted prior to the boat being parked in the winter boat parking lot. An administrative fee of \$20.00 will be charged for failure to submit the form prior to parking.
- 2. Proof of liability insurance is required by all users.
- 3. Only the registered boat owner may use the space assigned
- 4. Boats shall be secured to the trailer or platform with fully adequate lines or chains. The Recreation Department may ask owners to replace inadequate or unsafe lines/chains that could result in damage to other boats.
- 5. Boat owners are responsible to ensure that they do not infringe on the rights of other users.
- 6. Sailboat owners are required to tie back halyards and lines.
- 7. The Recreation Department does not provide supervision or security of any boat in the winter parking space.
- 8. It is our goal to ensure that all boats parked for winter storage are removed no later than 10 days after the Marina opens for operations. Failure to do so will result in monthly extension fees. (see below)
- 9. Individuals needing to extend their parking agreement must have writing approval from the Recreation Department and will be billed monthly for their extended boat parking.
- 10. Payment is required within 30 days of invoice. Failure to make payment will result in termination of agreement and the Town will have the right to take possession of the BOAT PARKING space.
