By-law No. 36-93 (as amended by By-laws 1-96 and 7-96)

A By-law to regulate the operation of motorized snow vehicles within the municipality.

WHEREAS authority for this By-law is contained in the *Motorized Snow Vehicles Act*, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.44, Section 7;

NOW THEREFORE The Council of the Corporation of the Town of Deep River ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Definitions

In this by-law:

- 1.1 "the Act" means the Motorized Snow Vehicles Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.44.
- 1.2 "motorized snow vehicle" means a self-propelled vehicle designed to be driven primarily on snow.
- 1.3 "highway" includes a common and public highway, street, avenue, parkway, driveway, square, place, bridge, viaduct or trestle, designed and intended for, or used by, the general public for the passage of vehicles.
- 1.4 "park" includes all lands owned by the Corporation of the Town of Deep River which have been set aside for public recreation.
- 1.5 "the prohibited area" means that portion of the Town of Deep River shown shaded on Schedule 'A' to this by-law, which is described as follows:

The area, including the named highways except as hereafter noted, bounded by Montcalm St., Poplar St. from Montcalm St. to Deep River Rd., Deep River Road from Poplar St. to Glendale Ave., Glendale Ave., from Deep River Rd. to Troyes St., Troyes St., Hillcrest Ave. from Troyes St. to Deep River Rd., and Ridge Rd. from Deep River Rd. to Montcalm St; excluding therefrom Poplar St., Forest Ave, and the portion of Montcalm St. between Poplar St. and Forest Ave.

1.6 "roadway" means the part of highway that is improved, designed or ordinarily used for vehicular traffic, and includes the ploughed portion of the shoulder.

2. Driving Prohibited in Parts of the Municipality

- 2.1 No person shall drive a motorized snow vehicle:
 - 2.1.1 in, across or upon any park except in designated areas shown on the map attached to and forming part of this by-law as Schedule 'A';
 - 2.1.2 along or upon Deep River Road, except to cross it in accordance with the Act;
 - 2.1.3 along or upon the roadway of Ridge Road, except to cross it in accordance with the Act;
 - 2.1.4 along or upon any sidewalk; or,
 - subject to subsection 2.3, along, across, or upon any highway, public place or parking lot whether publicly or privately owned in the prohibited area.
- 2.2 This section does not apply to where a motorized snow vehicle is driven as part of a parade or display authorized by Council of the Corporation of the Town of Deep River.
- 2.3 This section does not apply to prohibit parking of motorized snow vehicles on private property which abuts a highway on which a motorized snow vehicle may lawfully be driven.

3. Offences

Every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this by-law is guilty of an offence and is liable to the penalty provided for under the *Provincial Offences Act*.

4. Repeal of Former By-law.

By-law number 37-77 is hereby repealed.

5. Enactment

This By-law comes into force upon adoption by Council of the Corporation of the Town of Deep River.

A By-law to amend By-law 36-93, to regulate the operation of motorized snow vehicles within the municipality.

WHEREAS authority for this By-law is contained in the *Motorized Snow Vehicles Act*, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.44, Section 7;

AND WHEREAS on November 3, 1993, Council adopted By-law Number 36-93 to regulate the operation of motorized snow vehicles within the municipality;

AND WHEREAS on January 17, 1996, Council adopted By-law Number 1-96 to amend the said by-law 36-93;

AND WHEREAS Council now deems it wise to amend the said by-law in order to clarify the legality of motorized snow vehicles parking on property within the central commercial area of the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Deep River **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

- 1. By-law 36-93 is amended as follows:
 - 1.1 Section 2.1.5 is rescinded, and the following substituted therefor:
 - 2.1.5 subject to subsection 2.3, along, across, or upon any highway, public place or parking lot whether publicly or privately owned in the prohibited area.
 - 1.2 The following subsection is added to Section 2:
 - 2.3 This section does not apply to prohibit parking of motorized snow vehicles on private property which abuts a highway on which a motorized snow vehicle may lawfully be driven.
- This By-law comes into force upon adoption by Council of the Corporation of the Town of Deep River.
