Cell Phone Check the weather before you leave

1-2 liters of water Let someone know where you will be hiking

First Aid Kit Know how to use and follow the map

Flashlight Be aware of your surroundings

Matches

Extra Cloths including hat, gloves, jacket

Pocket knife.

What to do if you are lost:

Stay dry

Blow your whistle

Look for trail markers

Use your cell phone

Look around for a safe sheltered place

Don't panic

By being prepared you will enjoy your trip, reduce the chance of getting lost and if you do get lost, you'll be able to help others find you quickly and keep yourself safe and warm while you wait.
