- a) Pursuant to section 91 (1) of the *Community Safety and Policing Act (CSPA)*, the Deep River Police Service Board (the Board) may appoint auxiliary members of the Service;
- b) The Board may suspend or terminate the appointment of an auxiliary member. Before the auxiliary member's appointment is terminated the member shall be given written notice with respect to the reasons for the termination and an opportunity to respond orally or in writing, as determined by the Board;
- c) It is the policy of the Board with respect to the use of auxiliaries that the Chief of Police will:
 - I. Develop and maintain written procedures that address the use of auxiliaries by this Police Service in accordance with the *Community Safety and Policing Act* and its *Regulations*, if any;
 - II. Ensure that records are maintained relating to the use of auxiliaries.
