Pursuant to *Ontario Regulation Section 392/23 - Adequate and Effective Policing (General)* it is the policy of the Deep River Police Service Board (the Board) with respect to detainee care and control that the Chief of Police will:

a) Establish and maintain written procedures and processes for:

- I. The care and control of detainees, including effective monitoring;
- II. Responding to an escape from police custody;
- III. Handling item of Religious Significance;
- IV. Duty to Accommodate Persons with Disabilities;
- V. Privacy for Detainees;
- VI. Suicide Concerns – Special Precautions;
- VII. Mental Illness, Emotionally Disturbed, Development Disability;
- VIII. Medical Considerations Sick - Injured Detainees;
- IX. Excited Delirium, Positional Asphyxia, Obstructive Sleep Apnea;
- X. Intoxicated Detainees; and
- XI. Maintenance and Inspection of cell block.

b) Ensure that members involved in detainee care and control have the knowledge, skills and abilities required to perform this function; and

c) Following an escape or in-custody death, review the procedures, processes, and practices of the Police Service for detainee care and control and report back to the Board.
