## Deep River Police Department

### School Buses

Reminder: Drivers must stop for a school bus with its red lights flashing. Our children's safety is paramount.

It is unlawful to fail to stop for a stopped school bus that has its red lights flashing. A First Offence fine could be up to \$2,000 and six demerit points. For each following offence, up to \$4,000 and possible jail time up to six months.

In Ontario, school bus drivers and other witnesses can report to the police vehicles that have unlawfully passed a school bus and then the owner may be charged.

Let's ensure our children arrive safely.
