



Corporation of the Town of Deep River Election Compliance Audit Application Form Sections 88.33 (2) and / or 88.35 (2)

Under the *Municipal Elections Act*, 1996 (the “Act”), any eligible elector who believes that a Candidate or Registered Third Party Advertiser has contravened the campaign finance rules in the statute may apply for a Compliance Audit of that party’s election campaign finances.

To apply for a Compliance Audit of a Candidate for the office of Mayor, Reeve, Councillor or Registered Third Party Advertiser complete and submit this form and any supporting documents in person at the Town of Deep River Elections Office during regular business hours (Monday to Friday from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm).

The Elections Office must receive this form by the deadline(s) prescribed in Subsection 88.33(3) or Subsection 88.35(3) of the Act.

All applications will be submitted to the Election Compliance Audit Committee for review in accordance with the MEA.

DECLARATION

The definition of an 'eligible elector' under sub-section 17 (2) of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996 is as follows:

A person is entitled to be an elector at an election held in a local municipality if, on Voting Day they:

- a) Reside in the local municipality or are the owner or tenant of land there, or the spouse of such owner or tenant;
- b) Are a Canadian citizen;
- c) Are at least eighteen (18) years of age; and
- d) Are not prohibited from voting under sub-section 17 (3) or otherwise by law.

Accordingly, the following must be declared by the applicant:

I, _____, being an eligible elector in the Town of Deep River, **HEREBY DECLARE** that I have reasonable grounds to believe that the Candidate or Registered Third Party referenced in this application has contravened a provision of the *Municipal Elections Act*, 1996, relating to election campaign finances, and I have set out the reasons for my belief in this Application.
