Many people rent homes or apartments for vacations. **These rentals are not regulated like hotels and motels.** Practice home safety in rentals just like you do at home.



Make sure:

- everyone knows the **address** of the rental.
- there are working smoke and carbon monoxide alarms outside **each sleeping area** and on **every storey** of the rental.
- everyone knows **two ways out** of every room and out of the rental if there is an emergency.
- all doors and windows** that lead outside can be easily opened.
- you choose an **outside meeting place** a safe distance from the rental where everyone can meet and be accounted for in the event of a fire.

Distracted Driving Kills. Don't Text & Drive

Notice of Intention to Repeal By-Law Number 17-83

Take notice that Council of the Town of Deep River hereby gives notice of their intention to repeal By-Law Number 17-83, a By-Law to Designate Certain Properties in the Town of Deep River under the Ontario Heritage Act.

This notice is provided pursuant to Section 32 of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. O. 18, s. 32 (3).

On June 15, 1983 the property known municipally as 612 Highway 17 East being comprised of Part of Lots 44 and 45, Range 'A' in the Town of Deep River was designated to be of historical and architectural significance.

Following receipt of a written application by the property owner to the Town to request the Heritage designation be repealed, a comprehensive review of the designation was undertaken and on June 9, 2021 Council of the Corporation of the Town of Deep River resolved to issue a Notice of Intention to repeal By-law 17-83.

AN OBJECTION TO THE PROPOSED REPEAL MUST BE RECEIVED IN WRITING BY THE CLERK ON OR BEFORE: JULY 22, 2021.
