



THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF DEEP RIVER MAYORAL DECISION

Decision Number: MDE-2026-02

Subject: 2026 MUNICIPAL BUDGET

Whereas Subsection 284.16 (3) and (4) of Part VI.1 - Special Powers and Duties of the Head of Council under the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001 (the "Act") grants Council authority to amend the Town of Deep River's proposed budget and for a Strong Mayor to veto said amendments; and

Whereas the last date for Council to amend the Town's proposed 2026 Operating and Capital Budgets was March 2, 2026; and

Whereas under O. Reg. 530 / 22 sub-section 7(7) made under the Act permits the Head of Council to shorten the ten (10) day period to veto Council amendments to the proposed Operating and Capital Budgets;

Therefore, I Suzanne D'Eon, Mayor of the Town of Deep River, pursuant to the powers extended to the head of Council under Part VI.1 of the Municipal Act, 2001, and the amendments to O. Reg. 530 / 22 under sub-section 7(7) made under the Act, hereby decide as follows with respect to the 2026 Town of Deep River Municipal Budget:


1. I will not exercise the power to veto under subsection 284.16(4) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001.
2. This Mayoral Decision provides written notice under sub-section 7(7) of O. Reg. 530 / 22 to shorten the ten (10) day period to veto Council amendments to the proposed Operating and Capital Budgets to the date of this Mayoral Decision.

I understand that this means the proposed 2026 Operating and Capital Budgets is therefore deemed to be adopted.

This decision takes effect upon the signing and dating thereof, and will remain in effect until modified or revoked in writing.
