With school fast approaching, members of the Deep River Police Service would like to remind drivers that you must stop for a school bus with its red lights flashing. Our children's safety is paramount.

It is unlawful to fail to stop for a stopped school bus that has its red lights flashing. For your <u>First Offence</u> you could be fined up to \$2,000.00 and receive six demerit points and for each following offence, up to \$4,000.00 and possible jail time up to six months.

In Ontario, school bus drivers and other witnesses can report vehicles that have unlawfully passed a school bus and report it to police who then may charge the owner of the vehicle.

Let's ensure our children arrive safely at school and back home.
