

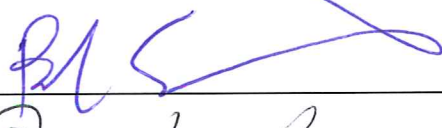
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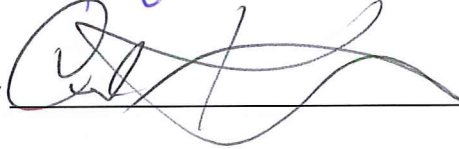


TOWNSHIP OF KILLALOE, HAGARTY AND RICHARDS

WHEREAS Council of the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards recognizes the importance of social and affordable housing and the County of Renfrew's responsibility for providing social housing; and

WHEREAS the Township recognizes that the Province of Ontario should be engaged regarding the adequacy of funding available to the County of Renfrew to support its social housing responsibilities; and

WHEREAS the County Treasurer presented a proposal on September 8, 2026, to change the property-tax treatment of properties owned by the Renfrew County Housing Corporation (RCHC); and

WHEREAS the proposed changes would result in the loss of property-tax revenue currently received by affected lower-tier municipalities, including the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards, and may have longer-term impacts on municipal revenues, assessment and the allocation of social housing costs; and

WHEREAS municipalities require sufficient information and time to understand the financial and long-term implications of a significant change to the property-tax treatment of RCHC properties and to provide meaningful input;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT Council of the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards supports the Town of Arnprior's Resolution No. 243-26 and requests that the County of Renfrew:

1. Defer consideration of the proposed changes until meaningful consultation has occurred with all affected lower-tier municipalities and the City of Pembroke;

2. Direct County staff to provide a comprehensive financial analysis outlining the impacts on each affected municipality, including:

- current and potential future property-tax revenue impacts;
- potential impacts on the municipal assessment base;
- changes to the allocation of social housing costs; and
- alternative approaches to minimize adverse financial impacts on municipalities; and

3. Defer any final decision until 2027, allowing the newly constituted County Council to consider the proposal, the financial analysis and feedback from affected municipalities.

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED THAT a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the MPP for Renfrew-Nipissing-Pembroke, Billy Denault, the Warden of the County of Renfrew, all members of Renfrew County Council, all lower-tier municipalities within the County of Renfrew, the City of Pembroke, and the Municipal Property Assessment Corporation (MPAC).
