The Deep River Fire Department is seeking dedicated individuals who embody the values of trust, honesty, integrity, compassion, and teamwork to fill upcoming Volunteer Firefighter positions.

If you're driven by a commitment to community safety and want to make a real difference, consider joining us as a Volunteer Firefighter. It's one of the most rewarding, dynamic, and impactful ways to serve your community.

Note: While the exact number of openings isn't yet known, this employment opportunity aims to build a pool of qualified candidates for upcoming roles.

Qualifications include; 18 years of age or older, possess a minimum Grade 12 (OSSD) education, and a valid Class G driver's licence with an acceptable driving record. Candidates are required to obtain a medical note from their Health Care Provider (Doctor), confirming they are medically fit to perform the duties of a Volunteer Firefighter. Compensation for this position is starting at \$23.00/hr, weekly on call premium of \$236.00/week.

Once hired, firefighters will be required to participate in the department's "On-Call Program and shall acquire mandatory Provincial certifications and licenses:

- **NFPA 1072 Hazardous Materials Responder – Awareness Level** within your first year of employment.
- **NFPA 1001 Firefighter Level 1 and 2 and NFPA 1072 Hazardous Materials Operations Level** within two years of employment.
- A valid **Class DZ Driver's License** within three years of employment.
- **Valid and current Red Cross certification** in First Aid/CPR/AED/Oxygen Therapy, Airway Management, and Basic Life Support (BLS) within your first year.

Qualified applicants are invited to submit a complete resume of qualifications along with copies of any formal education and/or experience/training.
