INFORMATION SHEET

Vacation is a time of fun and relaxation; do not let thieves ruin your time away. If you are planning a holiday, you may contact the Deep River Police Service and let us know when you intend to be away from your home. This service, which is intended for vacations of up to 8 weeks, will hopefully provide Town of Deep River Residents with some peace of mind during their time away. Time permitting; Deep River Police will conduct perimeter checks and be on the lookout for any suspicious circumstances.

If you are interested in having your home registered with the Deep River Police Service while on vacation, please call 613-584-3500 or complete the [Home Vacation Security Program](#) and deliver to our offices.

Be sure to have the following information ready:

- When you are leaving (date and time, if known)
- When you expect to return (date and time, if known)
- Your name, address, and phone number
- Whether there will be cars outside your residence while you are gone (include make, model and license number)
- Who has permission to enter the residence while you are gone (i.e, pet feeders, water plants, etc)
- An emergency contact name and number or Any other information you feel is important.

If you are looking for simple ways to reduce the chance of your holiday being ruined by crime, follow these crime prevention tips:

- Strive to make your home look as lived-in as possible while you are away.
- Do not broadcast your plans, but do let your neighbours know that you will be gone.
- Give a spare key to neighbor and give them an emergency telephone number to reach you.
- Arrange to have your mail and newspapers picked up daily (preferred) or have delivery stopped while you are away.
- Use automatic timers to turn on radio, lights, etc, at different intervals.
- Turn down ringer on your telephone. An unanswered telephone is a dead giveaway.
- Leave your blinds as you normally would if you were home.
- Be sure to lock the garage as well as any storage sheds, gates, etc. It is also a good idea to disconnect your garage door opener if you have one.
- Ask your neighbor to occasionally park in your driveway and put out your garbage bins if you have curbside pickup. A neighbour can throw in a bag of garbage.
- Be sure someone knows your itinerary and the estimated time of return.
- Secure or hide all ladders that are in your yard.
